1. Prove that  $\mathbb{R}$  is isomorphic to the ring  $S = \left\{ \begin{bmatrix} a & 0 \\ 0 & a \end{bmatrix} \in \text{Mat}_2(\mathbb{R}) \right\}$ .
2. Let  $\varphi : R \rightarrow S$  be a homomorphism of rings. If  $r$  is a zero divisor in  $R$ , is  $\varphi(r)$  a zero divisor in  $S$ ? If so, prove it. If not, give a counterexample.
3. (a) Show that  $S = \{0, 4, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24\}$  is a subring of  $\mathbb{Z}/28\mathbb{Z}$ .  
(b) Prove that the map  $\varphi : \mathbb{Z}/7\mathbb{Z} \rightarrow S$  given by  $\varphi([x]_7) = [8x]_{28}$  is an isomorphism.
4. Let  $\varphi : R \rightarrow S$  and  $\psi : S \rightarrow T$  be homomorphisms. Show that  $\psi \circ \varphi : R \rightarrow T$  is a homomorphism.
5. Let  $\varphi : R \rightarrow S$  be an isomorphism of rings. Which of the following properties are preserved by this isomorphism? (Be sure to justify your answers!)
  - (a)  $a \in R$  is a zero divisor.
  - (b)  $a \in R$  is an idempotent.
  - (c) if  $R$  is an integral domain then  $S$  is an integral domain.
6. Let  $f = 2x^4 + x^2 - x + 1$  and  $g = 2x - 1$  be polynomials in  $(\mathbb{Z}/5\mathbb{Z})[x]$ . Find polynomials  $q, r \in (\mathbb{Z}/5\mathbb{Z})[x]$  so that  $f = gq + r$  with  $r = [0]_5$  or  $\deg r < \deg g$ .
7. Let  $F$  be a field. Is  $F[x]$  a field? Justify your answer.
8. Is the collection of all polynomials in  $R[x]$  with constant term  $0_R$  a subring of  $R[x]$ ? Justify your answer.
